




5 Point Origami Star Step-by-Step




5 Point Origami Star Step-by-Step




1. Fold the shape in half down the centre, pressing firmly on the fold to make it a neat, crisp fold.



2. Continue folding the shape in half all of the ways it can be, until a fold line goes through every point.




3. Place a flat edge of the shape towards you and fold it up into the shape until the two corners meet the diagonal lines that run through the corners here. Firmly press down and create the fold.




4. Repeat this with each flat edge, making each fold as sharp as possible. You should end up with something similar to the above.

5. With the flat edge towards you, fold up the bottom section. At the same time bring in the side fold. Doing this will cause a corner to appear.

6. As you bring up the two sides you may need to pinch the corner from the outside of the shape, guiding it in and making this corner sharp.




7. The side fold should come in first, then lift up the lower fold. This will create a triangular over hang to the side. Press down firmly on this shape to create a crease underneath.

8. Rotate the shape until you have done this with each side. You should do every fold 5 times.

9. When you open up your shape now you should see in the centre of the paper there is a pentagon shape and from each corner there should be a clearly defined triangle coming out from it.


Pinching these triangles together should cause the shape to start to come in on itself, almost creating a bowl-like shape.



Look for a fold this shape coming from each corner of the central pentagon shape in the middle of your paper.




10. From the bowl-like shape, start to coax the folds in on themselves. This is the tricky bit, don't worry if it takes you a few attempts.

If you've firmly pressed down on all of your folds, making them as crisp as possible, it should now all start to collapse in, with the shape folding itself down.




11. When the folds have come together and it's laying flat, it will have taken on a star shape, with a smaller pentagon in the middle made up of triangles.

Now turn it over.



11. When you turn the shape over you'll now see a larger pentagon, with triangles sitting underneath it.



Take each corner of the pentagon and fold it into the central point. As you do this the triangle will fold in half, giving you the point of the star.



12. Press down neatly here and you will create a fold line down the centre of that triangle.

Repeat with a further 3 corners until you have 4 or your star's points. Leave one unfolded.



13. When you get to the last point you'll need to unfold the first you did in order to tuck your last one under.

14. Once it's unfolded, take the pentagon's corner up to the centre as you have done with the others, carrying on the fold through the triangle right down to the other side.

You can then fold back the first star point you made.



15. Press down firmly on all your folds and your star is now done!
